SUBMIT YOUR SECONDARY AND POST-SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS

Official transcripts of your high school and post-secondary records are required. If you have 30 or more semester hours that will transfer to KSU, only post-secondary records are required. All transcripts must be translated to English and evaluated by a currently approved credential service from www.naces.org. English evaluations and transcripts must be sent to KSU directly from the evaluating service.

SUBMIT YOUR SAT/ACT SCORES IF YOU ARE APPLYING AS A FRESHMAN OR TRANSFER FRESHMAN

KSU School Code for SAT is 5359

KSU School Code for ACT is 0833

SUBMIT EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Required for students from non-English speaking countries. This can include TOEFL scores, IELTS scores, or successful completion of the KSU Intensive English Program through Level Six.

KSU School Code for TOEFL is 5359. Minimum scores are required.

SUBMIT YOUR PROOF OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

F-1 Visa students must provide evidence of financial support including:

- Affidavit from your financial sponsor indicating support required by the institution
- Sworn or notarized letter from sponsor's bank showing required funds available, in U.S. dollars
